He was working as Sr. Assistant Editor and Chief of the Business Bureau of Ei-Samay Newspaper, where he worked since its inception in 2012. He also worked in The Telegraph, The Financial Express and Paschim Banga Sanvad. He was a specialist in the areas of Personal Finance, Banking and Mutual Funds. He was instrumental in introducing and popularising Info graphics in the paper. A Post Graduate in Economics from Bardhaman University, he joined the financial sector and later switched over to Business and Financial Journalism, where he worked as a leading Business Journalist till the end of his life..
