He started his journalistic career in Satyajug. He joined Bartaman since its inception in 1984 and continued there until his retirement. After that he was associated with Sandhya Satyajug.

He became the Secretary of the Club for two tenures. He was Club minded and extended his patronage in all the activities of the Club. He was an acclaimed mountaineer and associated with The Himalayan Association, Kolkata.

He was soft spoken, amiable and very helpful to his colleagues and juniors. His coverage of Legislative Assembly was always praiseworthy. He was also a stalwart in covering Administration including the Power Sector. He will be remembered for his smiling face, friendly attitude and helpful nature.
